Welcome back ANCS Parents and Teachers!

You may have heard that our Loyalty Programs (previously "Incentive Programs") brought in more than \$4000 last year. That's a good amount of "free" money for our school!

Funds raised are used to support the PTCA, which in turn supports the work that you do in your classrooms. In the past, the PTCA purchased furniture and equipment for the Media Center as well as much needed supplies at the specific request of several teachers. Funds also supported the "Traveling Trunk" series, Teacher Appreciation Week, and a number of other events throughout the year.

There are six programs we focus on.....

1) Box Tops 4 Education: Clip the "Box Tops" coupon off participating products and have your child bring them into class once a month. ANCS receives 10 cents for every "Box Top" it collects. We can generate a significant amount of money (~\$1000), if everyone participates. Go to www.boxtops4education.com for more information about the program and ways to earn more money for ANCS.

Box Tops Marketplace: A part of the Box Tops for Education website- Over 100 retailers give eBoxTops to your school when you shop online at the Marketplace. Plus, you become an Online Power Earner and can earn Bonus Box Tops!

2) Campbell's Labels for Education: Same concept as Box Tops 4 Education, except the school earns points which it can redeem for various school items like a Mac computer, Audio/Visual equipment, cameras, books, etc. Clip the coupons and bring them to school once a month. www.labelsforeducation.com

3) Georgia Natural Gas True Blue Schools: Now this program is pretty simple and while it only requires a few minutes of your time, the payoff is pretty big for AANCS. Georgia Natural Gas pay ANCS \$5 per month for every month you remain a customer. Are you already a Georgia Natural Gas customer? Well, sign-up and the school will receive \$5 per month. 5) **Publix Partners:** Pick-up a Publix key tag in the main office of the Elementary School and make sure the checker swipes it every time you shop at Publix. Publix will cut a check to ANCS every year for a percentage of the sales. Pretty simple.
