➤ Grades 6-8: 1

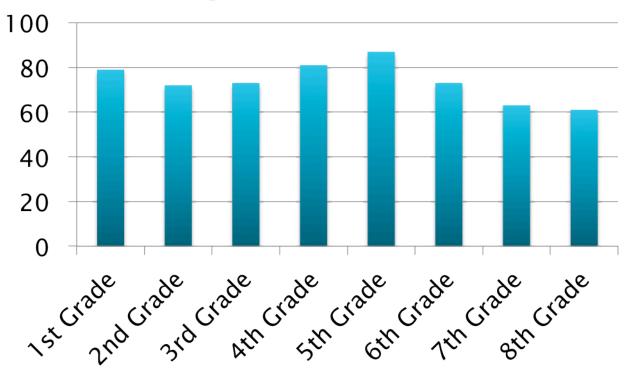

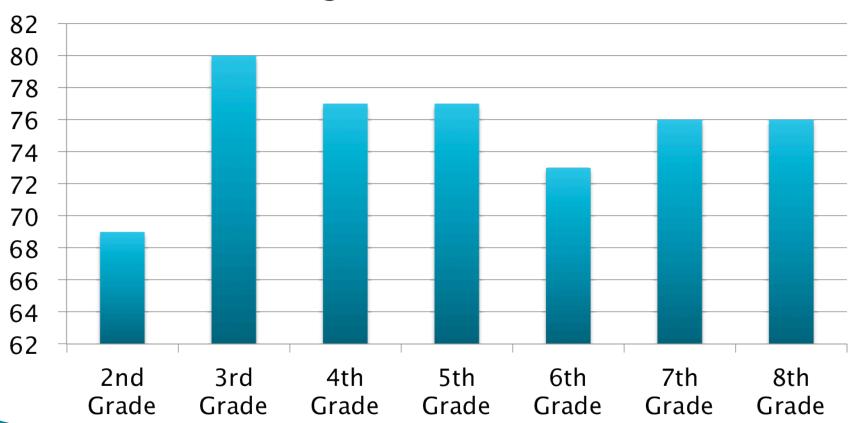
Accountability & Compliance STAR Math - 2012-13 Performance

Accountability & Compliance ANCS Strategic Plan Update

- ANCS charter agreement calls for regular updating of school's strategic plan, initially developed by NCS
- One of the plan's strategic objectives was to merge NCS and ACMS
- The merger of these two schools and the evolution of the school's governance and administrative structures necessitates a robust update process to reflect the current school community
