



A resolution of the Governing Board of Atlanta Neighborhood Charter School, hereafter referred to as Neighborhood Charter

**Whereas** it is part of Neighborhood Charter's mission to both advocate in the larger community for student centered schools and build an inclusive community of students, parents and educators;
