MEETING MINUTES:

I. Welcome & Introductions - Jenny Gunn and Meeghan Fortson introduced themselves as co-presidents of the PTCA and introduced all members of the PTCA Executive Committee (www.atlncs.org/ptca), including DEAT representatives (Carla Wells, Leslie Jo Tottenham, Nichole Lupo) and Faculty/Staff representatives (Kim Moran & Maria McFeeley)

II. State of the School, Chuck Meadows, ANCS Executive Director

- Where have we come from? BC (Before COVID) we have continued to thrive because of parents and staff that care
- Our teacher turnover rate is only 10% and have 11 years of teaching experience average.
- Aug 12th marked the 20th anniversary of our first day of school. Second oldest charter school in the city. We have not grown capped enrollment and we are in demand.
- This is the first lottery that changed and met our goals of social/economic diversity.
- Fundraising: Recapped in the 08/17 Courier; PTCA no longer seeking membership fees; donations will be sought for Gather and Grow and distributed to support the PTCA among other goals
- Room Parent Class Collections: Recapped in the 08/17 Courier. Room parents at the elementary campus will no longer be tasked with collecting and tracking money from other parents for class socials and teacher gifts each class will instead be allocated a budget upfront.
- This year we will be helping all students to know themselves focus on identity. Focus and understand who you are as a person.
- Hiring 2 new diversity and inclusion roles; will work with the PTCA on equity among other duties

A: The Fund Development Committee is meeting about this; the committee meets monthly to develop fundraising strategy and messaging. Money is centralized through "Gather and Grow". It will be clear when you give to that, you are giving to the other initiatives such as the PTCA.

Q: Is Third-Friday Coffee only at one campus?
