And, parents can track information on the site and receive email notification of their child's achievements. **NEW!** All players may participate in online game play 3 afternoons a week, playing children from many of our school clubs in Atlanta (4:30-5:30) using the Lichess.org platform; also there will be one free virtual Swiss-style tournament held every Friday. Intermediate and Advanced players will have access to information about recommended upcoming USCF rated tournaments.
