## I. Recent PTCA events :

<u>A.</u> Elementary school hosted Super Villains and Super Hero's Bingo Night on Friday, 2/10. It was a financial success. They were able to net \$2,549.05. To date we have received over \$34,481 in Mini-Grant applications and have given away more than \$13,317.
