



## **Elementary Campus Student Reporting System Update**

Over past several years received consistent feedback from both parents and teachers about current elementary student reporting system:

### ***Parent feedback:***

- "Grades" hard to understand
- Vague
- Not enough information

### ***Teacher feedback:***

- Vague
- Difficult to match report card grades with class assessments
- Extremely time consuming - especially with conferences right after reports the first term

Seeing that a change in the reporting system was necessary, the elementary campus leadership has taken the following steps:

- 2014 Summer Grading Task Force
- Norming and Alignment of assessment and grading practices
- Norming of grading definitions
- Creating draft of new reporting system

In final stages of creating new reporting system to begin using in 2016-17 school year:

- Conference after 6 week mark – 7<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> weeks
  - 18-Week progress report
  - Conference during the 24<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> week
  - 36-Week report card
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
