EDUCATE 2 SKATE

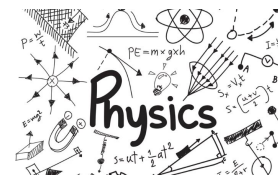

READING BOWL

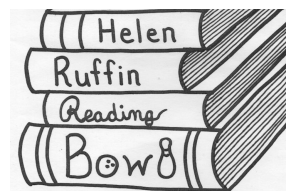

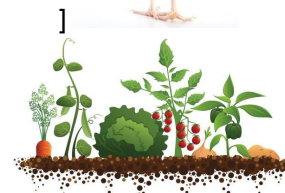
